

Privacy Policy for Lilleheden A/S

Thank you for visiting our webpage.

It is important for us to protect and respect your privacy in combination with your choice to use our services. We treat your personal information securely, so you remain safe using our services.

In our Privacy Policy you may read how we process your personal data and the rights you have in connection with using our products and services.

Processing

We responsibly process personal data, particularly due to administration of staff, business activities with both customers and suppliers and for marketing purposes.

We keep internal records of our processes.

Visits to our homepage and social medias

When visiting the homepage for Lilleheden or using our other online services (LinkedIn and Facebook), we collect information about your IP-address as well as information about your computer, unit, and browser.

We also collect information about your visit (i.e., information about the way you enter our homepage, how you navigate on it, which pages you visit, the content you look at, your searches, ads you view etc.). This information is collected by use of cookies, logfiles and other technologies.

We also collect data provide by you when you use our homepage or online services (i.e., filling a form, registering online, such as your name, company name, company address, work phone no, e-mail address, title, interest in product, plus other given information).

We collect the data to offer you the most relevant products and services and to improve your experience

with our homepage and the services and products we offer.

Our basis for this is legitimate interest (GDPR article 6, sec. 1, lit. f) or your consent (GDPR article 6, sec. 1, lit. a, and announcement conc cookies §3).

Collaboration with customers

We collect and process the needed personal information to collaborate with our customers. We limit ourselves to only collect and process the needed information, incl to fulfill our obligations.

As far as collaboration with customers we typical only process ordinary personal information, such as name, address, phone no, e-mail address and job title.

This process is necessary to pursue our legitimate interest to administrate our company and fulfill our obligations to clients.

Our basis for this is legitimate interest (GDPR article 6, sec. 1, lit. b) or legitimate interest (GDPR article 6, sec. 1, lit. f).

Suppliers

We collect and process the needed personal information to collaborate with our suppliers and other partners. We limit ourselves to only collect and process the needed information, incl to fulfill our obligations.

As far as collaboration with suppliers and other partners, we typical only process ordinary personal information, such as name, address, phone no, e-mail address and job title. Furthermore, there will be information given in e-mails and phone conversations. This process is necessary to pursue our legitimate interest to administrate our company and ordinary business operations.

Our basis for this is legitimate interest (GDPR article 6, sec. 1, lit. f) or your consent (GDPR article 6, sec. 1, lit. b).

Where do we collect the informations?

The collected personal information is primarily given from the persons themselves. Furthermore, in some extend from others, such as public databases and others.

Passing on of personal information

Subject to which kind of personal information and the context in which they appear we are allowed to pass it on to third person, such as the public authorities.

To some extend we also share person information with our Transporting partner when necessary. We make sure to have the proper legal base before sharing with anyone.

Protection of personal information

We will assure the proper confidentiality and integrity in our handling of all personal information. Our technical safeguards include the safety within the IT-solution we use at Lilleheden A/S.

Internally by the guidelines and politics of which our organizational security measures consist for our employees. Furthermore, we secure that we are in legal compliance with the GDPR.

Deletion

The personal information we collect, will be deleted as soon as we have processed them.

Your rights

We respect the rights of the person of whom we collect and process personal information.

These rights include:

- The right to ask for access into/ confirmation of / deletion of your process
- The right to restrict our process of your personal information
- The right to refuse process and
- The right on some occasions to obtain own personal information
- The right to withdraw consent
